

SCUBAPRO G260/MK17 | £379 (€486)



PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Scubapro has been making regulators for over 50 years, and the G260 second stage has that retro appeal for those lamenting the passing of the tried-and-tested G250. Teamed up with the MK17 first stage, it is a well-specified, decently priced set-up. It has an environmentally sealed first stage, four low-pressure ports, two high-pressure ports, large purge, big venturi lever, and cracking resistance control.

TEST TEAM COMMENTS

Coming in at a bargain price, the MK17/G260 rig gave a good account of itself. Mark singled out the draw of the 'old-school looks', and the other three agreed that it was an attractive regulator. Previous Scubapro regs have sometimes had small venturi



levers, but not this one - it is a big 'fin' easy to operate when wearing gloves. Will said that the mouthpiece 'was very comfortable', and Matt praised the 'easy-to-locate and use controls'. The large purge also got the thumbs up.
