These lightweight monoprene travel fins are designed to be worn comfortably barefoot, or with neoprene socks, thanks to the ultra-soft foot pocket and its comfortable, self-adjusting bungee heel strap.

Strong but exceptionally flexible, they are only 56cm long in size XL, and take up minimal space, as a cleverly thought-out interlocking tooth setup on the blades keeps the two fins together when they're not being used. Angled at 25° for optimal performance, the blades have integrated power bars on the underside, which are designed to counter overflexing and retain blade-shape when under load.

Scubapro's Synergy Twin is a dual-lens, low-volume mask that offers an all-round



wide field of view. Its soft and clingy silicone skirt is very comfortable and the quick release buckles attached directly to tabs on the skirt allow it to be folded flat for travelling. The Spectra semi-dry snorkel features a large bore tube with a flexible corrugated joint and a one-way valve at its base for simple, but effective clearing.
