## Scubapro Dry Bag 45 ▶▶▶▶

This compact rucksack, with its 45-litre capacity, could make a useful addition to your dive luggage. It is made from waterproof tarpaulin material, so whatever is inside it should stay dry or, at least, not leak out. So you can keep clothes, phones and tablets inside it for safety or fill it with water to have an instant pop-up camera rinse tank. It even has a drain valve. Price: £67.
